- E. Touch the Lake Campaign Discussion & Action Items
 - Connie referred to the map, which was handed out.
 - Four coupon categories are represented: Wellness, recreation, dining, art.
 - Road icons and TART locations were added
 - Mileage from/to Tahoe Towns were add
 - On the back of the map, there links to 8 businesses from each area, will be a link will be online, to website
 - Ski Resorts will be added on the map
 - Each business featured that have coupons will have a coupon
 - Social Media Photo Contest Online via Facebook, Twitter, Instagram #touchlaketahoe. All photos will be added into the main FB page
 - Instructions explaining the best way to get the message out will be distributed to members via a zip file from Abbi Agency
 - Suggestion by Caroline to change "Tahoe Towns" to "Lakeside Towns"
 - Maximum amount of coupons is 20. (Two more are needed.)
 - Comment by Caroline to combine businesses who have more than one coupon, and if they have two, to separate them.
 - Connie would require logo, offer and blackout dates by the end of the day tomorrow (Friday, Dec. 9th). A 15% discount is preferred, or a buy one/get one deal.
 - Caroline suggested to add "scenic helicopter rides" on the coupon
 - Distribution, both visitor centers, major lodging properties are being reached out to, and vacation rental properties.
 - Connie is developing a FAQ sheet for staff of businesses handing out map.
 - Final Draft next Wednesday, physical Distribution is scheduled for Jan 2nd. To continue to hand out through March 31st.

- Joy suggested an expiration date on the coupons.
- Caroline suggested that TART should be represented by the TART logo instead of a bus.

F. Shop Local Holiday contest Discussion & Action Items

- Caroline reported printed 12,500 cards and an additional card printing of 2,500
- She referred to the budget handout, and it is right on budget.
- The staycation grand prize: 3 nights at Mourelatos, estimated \$600 value and no black out, to expire in one year.
- On handout, everything in black is secured and paid for. Items in red are suggestions.
- Tahoe Yoga and wellness was suggested for inclusion, since it is a spa and at Northstar.
- Natalie should contact members to add to prizes, sticking within the budget.
- Seasonal ideas are discouraged. Skating was suggested by Adam, whether it is roller skating or ice skating, at Northstar.
- A deadline is set for Dec. 15th for submitting prizes.
- Firesign will donate, according to Stacie. Art Haus prize may be donated. Suggestion to begin seeking donations after seeing how much the spa is going to cost and then go to the Art Haus, or lakes
- Contest ends December 24th, then cards need to be collected. The drawing is January 5th. Data entry could be completed afterwards. There is a template in Excel, a spreadsheet, and Caroline will distribute it to everyone.
- Suggestion by Joy to divide cards equally between all to input the card information.
- Discussion regarding tracking sticker colors/districts and whether the information will be valuable to track.
- Stacie requested photos. Connie will call Stacie and see if she can use some that Abbi Agency has.
