8. Placer County Trash and Traffic Mitigation Efforts; Emily Setzer

Steve Lamb- GM Plump Jack Squaw Valley – Squaw Valley Business Association

Pedestrian Flaggers have been added to the crosswalks. Not designed to stop traffic but to que the people walking across the crosswalks to get a larger group gathered, then let them all cross at once.

They will continue this until visitation drops. They are working with Caltrans for a review to get temporary light signals installed. Installed for TC and KB at the roundabouts.

Trash installations in Kings Beach (one in state park rec area parking lot) and the other at Secline beach. Increased pickup in Kings Beach-looking at adding a 4<sup>th</sup> day

Tahoe City owners were responsible, now Placer is funding 3 pickups a week.

Household trash exemption- if they don't use trash, they don't have to pay for it.

Signage to slip in clear protectors and tape to dumpsters to encourage people to put trash in bins.

Hand Sanitizer stands throughout the downtown. Town of Truckee paid for metal posts and then businesses pay for the refills

Bathroom issues in Kings Beach and Tahoe City- State parks shuts down BRs early. Folks are using folks front yards to relieve themselves. KB looking at asking State parks to provide porta-potties. More in July/August!

# **Squaw Valley: Caroline Ross**

Things are going well at the village, restaurants that are operating with outdoor and to go are doing better than expected. 75% of normal. Lodging is also exceeding projections. Midweek is declining.

All events are cancelled! Made in Tahoe just cancelled. Live music on the weekends, very well received. Implemented a bingo night the last 8 weekends, family bingo on Friday nights (rotating restaurants). Tram has been closed due to maintenance. Doesn't see it opening before winter. Name change, Ron Cohen had a town hall about the history of the name Squaw Valley and the possible name change. There will be more communications about it next week, they will move forward next week.

# Kings Beach: Alyssa Reilly

Music on the Beach — Virtual Vibes was extremely successful, sold out of cups, averaged \$100/donor. Alibi partnership was very helpful. One of the events had funding donated to Pam Emmerich. Views 3000 average, one was 10,000, 8000 out of San Diego. Postponed Passport to Dining. BOD wants to do educational Food series. They are going to do a Survey to restaurants, what would be beneficial to them. What would they want to do? Labor day fireworks canceled at Garwoods.

### <u>Tahoe City: Kylee Bigelow</u>

TC has been busy, businesses are doing really well right now. People are frequenting the retail stores. Back yard boogie radio show, highlighting old recordings from some of the best shows from Concert on the Commons! Get Takeout, get a picnic and take photos and share old memories, while creating new safe memories. Tahoe City Explorathon — month long digital challenge based event. Support businesses, have fun, get outside! Track their challenges and submit content on Goosechase App. Photo challenges, trivia, etc. Looking for sponsors for the event. Sponsors can create challenges.

### Incline Village: Greg Long

#### Paul Raymore: IVGID

Waiting on Ski California and other updates from California to come up with flexible plans. Diamond Peak may look at opening uphill access.

#### Northstar: Amy Kylberg

Able to successfully open bike park, it has been on a 4 day a week basis. Was supposed to end last week (Friday-Sun) but due to demand they are keeping it 4 days a week. Cap is 350 passes a day. Sanitizing cabins after each use, spacing, looking at que lines. Looking at outdoor/indoor dining options. This winter will be different and we need to look at it as more of a pure skiing experience. Looking at Grab and Go options. Restaurants that have been open have been highly successful. They've expanded liquor licenses and able to expand patios. Lodging facilities have been impacted. A lot coming down the road, with the success of summer operations, they will be able to go into winter and focus on safety and guest experience.
