


Our Mission





- 3 weeks with guest master teachers from around the country, working in disciplines of classical ballet, contemporary, improvisation and modern dance.
- Offered at a tuition to local students that is 75% less than the national average price for similar programs. One third of local students receive full scholarships on the basis of financial need.

AFFORDABLE TICKET PRICES

As performing arts organizations across the nation raise ticket prices to stay afloat, in greater competition for audience attention, LTDF keeps is general admission prices at \$30 for Adults, \$25 for students and seniors, and \$15 for children. These prices are less than half the average ticket price to attend a a performance of a similar caliber or professional artists.


